



## THE SOLUTION

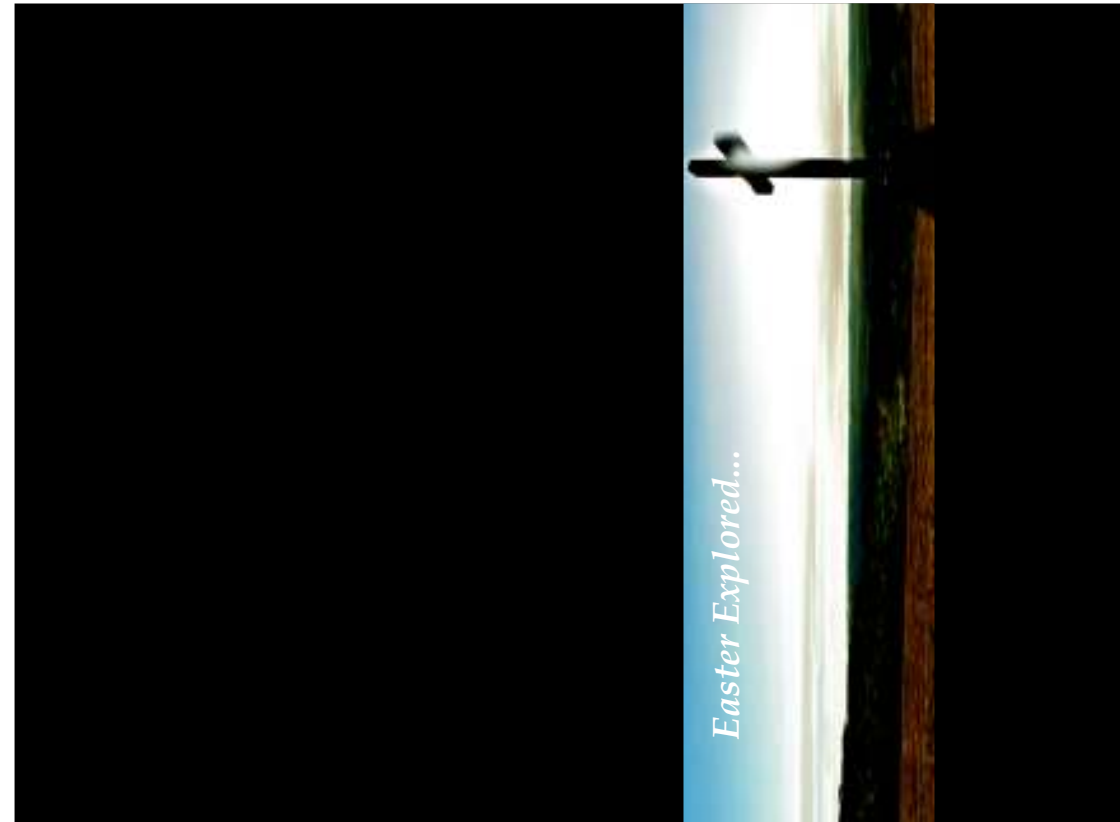
## THE GIFT
