Each sample pack will contain assorted tracts and e-cards as well as an inspiring audio CD and teaching DVD. We pray these will be useful resources for the Christian community in these countries.

**Website:** The GO International website ([www.gospel-outreach.org](http://www.gospel-outreach.org)) should be up and running within a week. The site will contain a large number of resources for dozens of countries including 'The Test' tract in at least 7 languages. E-cards have been designed for over 120 countries so far but translations are still needed for most of them. This is a very exciting step as we seek to reach out to the world with the Gospel.

### Partnership Opportunities

With many new opportunities opening up we would like to invite you to get involved in what God is doing through this ministry. The following are just some of the current options...

- **Sponsor a school outreach:** We are looking to reach more students with Gospel tracts this year and want to give you the opportunity to sponsor the

resources distributed at a particular school (maybe the one you attended or where your children attend?). The cost is 15c per student.

- **Part-time office worker:** As the ministry continues to expand so does the paper work and administration. We are looking for a person who would be willing to donate their time to help with this vital aspect of the ministry. At this stage it would be 5-10 hours a week. The role would include sending off invoices, posting off orders, doing the banking, clearing our P.O. Box, making up sample packs and other jobs as they arise. - **Support for a full-time worker:** We need to find funding to support a full-time worker who can visit churches, teach seminars, mentor evangelists etc. We are budgeting for \$500 a week. If you are able to contribute to this fund please see below\*.
- **Tract distributors:** We are in need of willing tract/e-card distributors. If you have some spare time in the afternoon (3pm-4pm) and would like to take part in distributing the Gospel to High School students please contact us.
