GO Tonga mission trip report



The GO Tonga team has just completed a very productive time in Tonga. In just 2 weeks they managed to distribute over 19,000 tracts and share the Gospel message in schools, in prison, on the street, in hospital, on TV, on the radio and in Church. The team used a variety of tools such as flip charts, tracts, Gospel illusions, drama and sketch boards. The team also spent time training and encouraging local evangelists and gave resources to help them reach out to their own people with the Gospel message.

As well as reaching the local people there was also an opportunity to reach dozens of royalty, leaders and well known celebrities with the Gospel message including the NZ Prime Minister Helen Clarke and the current Fijian Prime Minister Frank Bainimarama.
